REGIONAL TRIAL FORMAT - 'DISTRICT TEAMS'

The following sports require districts to conduct a district trial to select a district team prior to attending the regional trial.

Nomination Process:

- 1. Students must register their interest with their School Sport Coordinator.
- 2. Students must collect the appropriate district paperwork from their School Sport Coordinator.
- 3. Students must follow their district process to register for the district trial.

- Students must register their interest with their School Sport Coordinator and collect the following forms;
 - Expression of Interest Regional Trial Form
 - Regional Trial Permission / Consent Form 2020
- Code of Conduct Form
- Mouthguard Consent Form Regional Trial (if applicable)
- 2. Follow the instructions listed on the Expression of Interest Regional Trial Form.
- 4. Students must submit their completed Regional Trial Permission / Consent Form to the regional convenor upon check-in at regional trial.
